

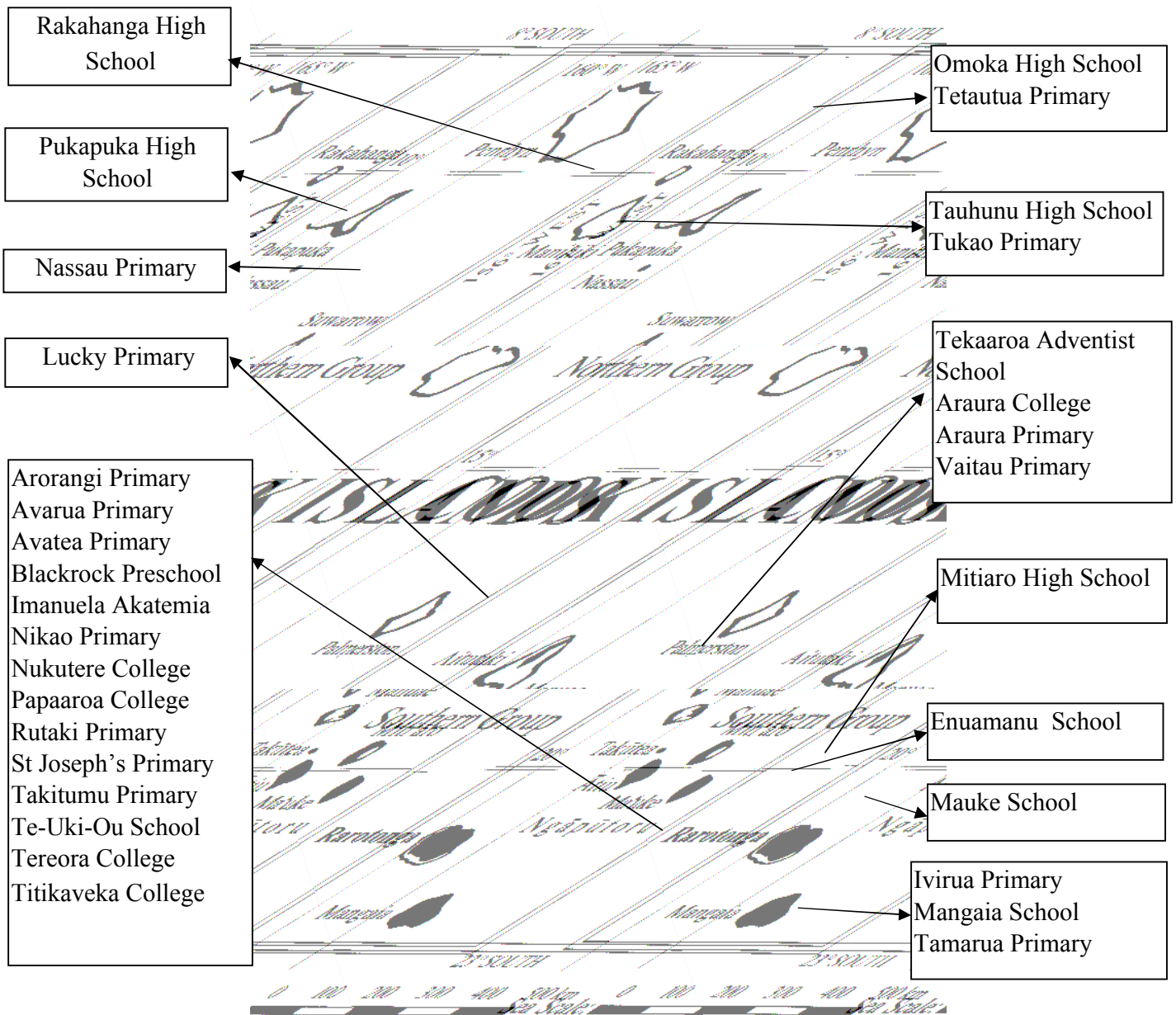
COOK ISLANDS SCHOOLS

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOLS

The Cook Islands consists of 15 islands. Rarotonga is the main island in terms of population and economic activity. The Southern Group, which excludes Rarotonga in this digest, consists of 7 islands, 2 of which (Manuae and Takutea) are not permanently populated. The least populated region is the Northern Group. The group consists of 7 islands with only Suvarrow lacking permanent population.

Schools are established on all 12 permanently populated islands. All 32 schools in the Cook Islands are co-educational. There are 14 schools on Rarotonga, 10 in the Southern Group and 8 in the Northern Group.

STATUS OF SCHOOLS

The Government has established schools on all twelve permanently inhabited islands. "Private " is used to denote a non-government school neither owned nor operated by a religious organisation. The two private schools, Blackrock Preschool and Te-Uki-Ou Primary, are located on Rarotonga. There are also four Church schools on Rarotonga. Two are administered by the Catholic Church (St Joseph's and Nukutere), one by the Seventh Day Adventist Church (Papaaroa) and one by the Assembly of God Church (Imanuela Akatemala). The SDA Church also administers a primary school (Tekaaroa) on Aitutaki.

LEVELS OF SCHOOL

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION(ECE) students are children aged from 3 years 6 months up to 4 years 11 months inclusive who are voluntarily enrolled for pre-school instruction.

PRIMARY students are children who are enrolled for instruction at Grade 1 - 6 level. Attendance is compulsory from the age of 5. The expected age range is from 5 to 10 years if a child spends one year in each grade.

SECONDARY students are children and young adults who are enrolled for instruction at Year 7 - Senior Level 3. Attendance is compulsory until the end of the year in which a student turns 15 or up to 19 years of age.

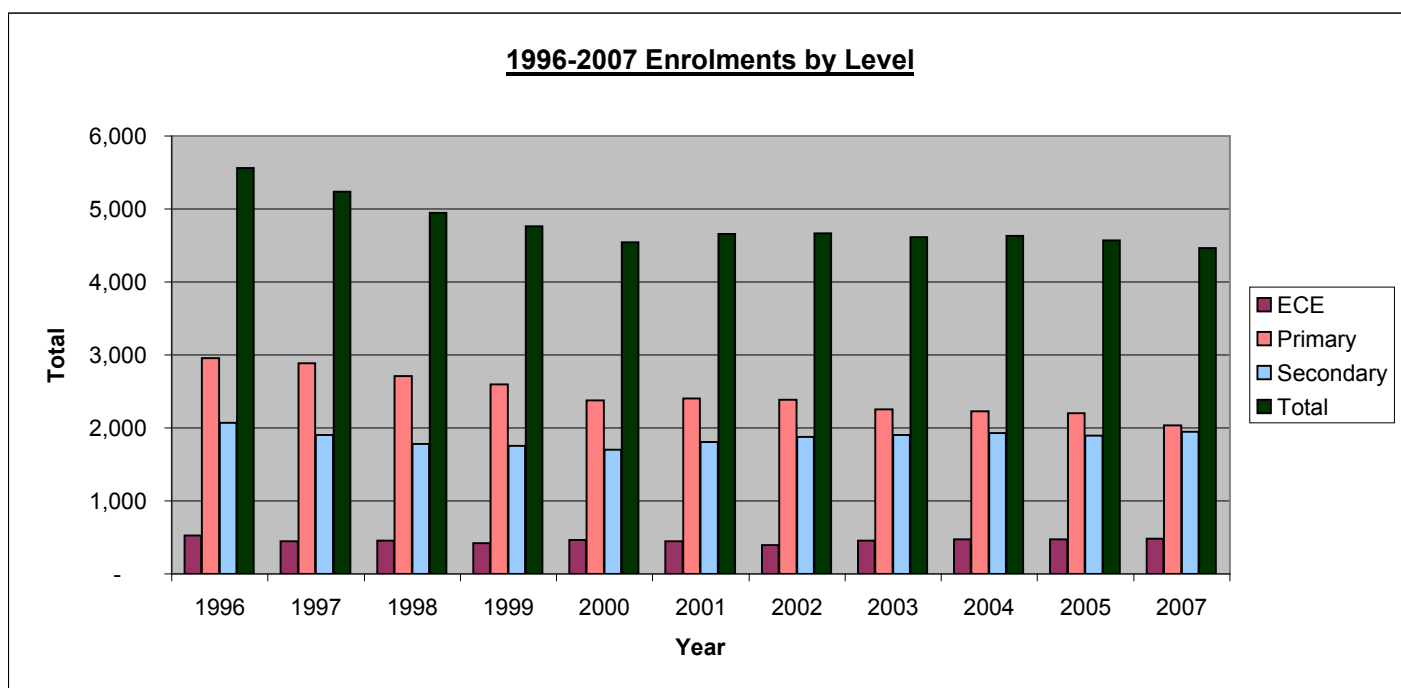

Data for 1996 to 2007 is derived from the EMIS.

Since 1996 there has been a 51(10%) decrease in ECE rolls, a 925(31%) decrease in primary rolls and a 123(6%) decrease in secondary rolls. The overall decrease since 1996 is 1099(20%).

There appears to be an increase in secondary school rolls since 2002. This maybe an indication of NCEA increasing retention.

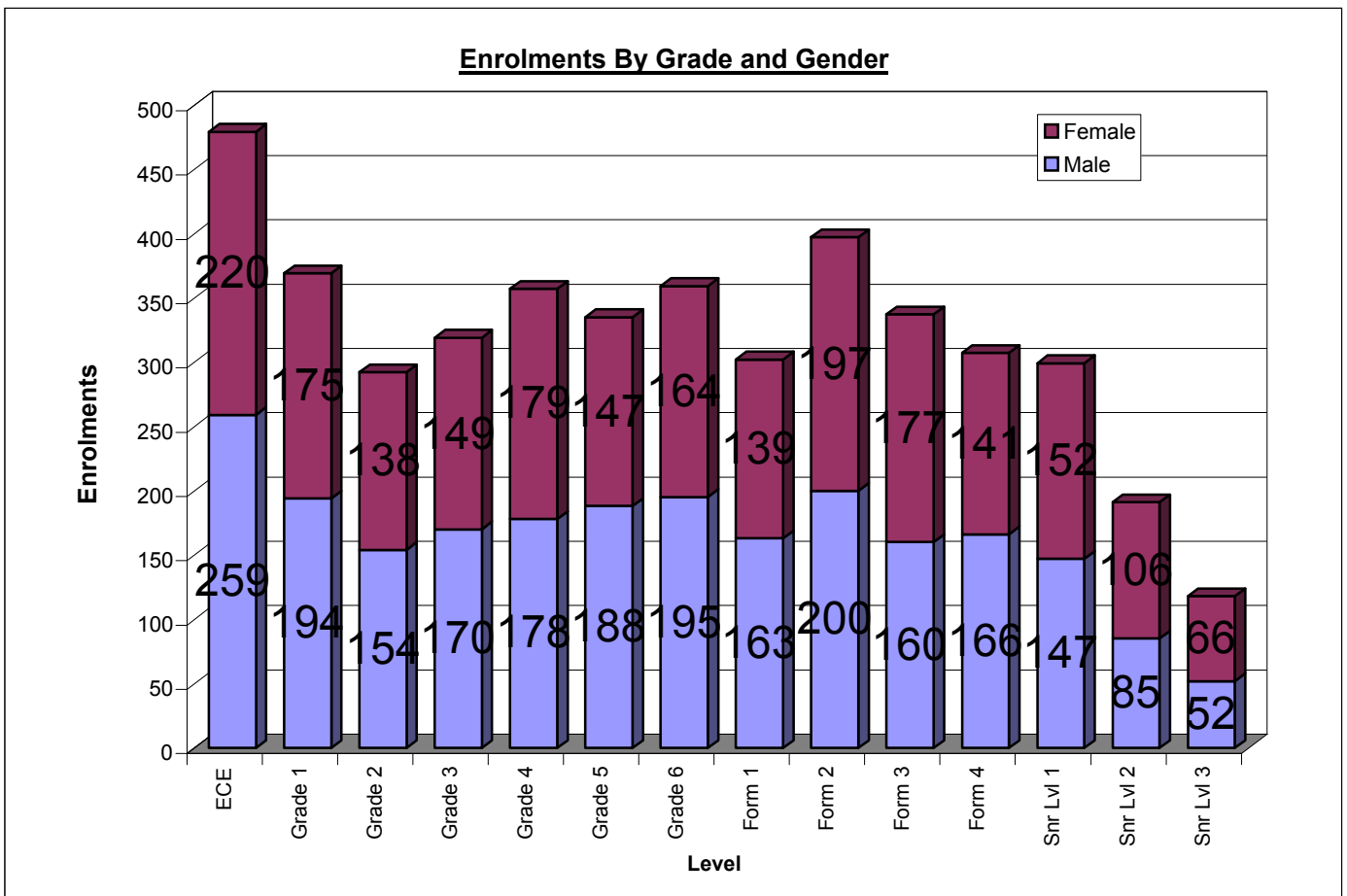

46% of students in ECE are female and about 47% of primary school (G1-G6) students are girls. At secondary (Y7-Y13) level, an average of 51% are girls. This suggests that overall, there are more boys this year than girls.

The overage data is based on the assumption that, on January 1, a Grade 1 student should be 5, a Grade 2 student should be 6 and each succeeding Grade student should be one year older. Those older than the assumed age for the grade are deemed to be overage.

The number of students repeating at each level is directly recorded on each school's 2007 EMIS survey form by the school's principal.
The Ministry does not encourage students to repeat years in the primary school where it believes Social progression is more important. Teachers are supported in providing independent programmes for students requiring extra support.
